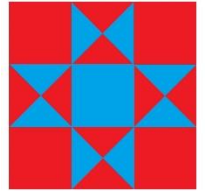

One street west of Michigan on Kessler Blvd. E-W, go south on Knollton (next to fire station, across from Crooked Creek School and Washington Cemetery). Watch for the church sign and turn left on 46th Street. The church is set back off the road on the left among the trees. **From the South:** SR65 North to 38th Street exit/Kessler Blvd. N-S, North on Kessler, east on 44th to Knollton, north on Knollton to 46th Street.
