| Pieced Bed – Large | 3000 – 3200 | Width: greater than 80" | Height: Any |
| Pieced Bed – Twin | 3300 – 3500 | Width: 60" to 80" | Height: Any |
| Pieced Large Wall or Lap | 3600 - 3800 | Width: 45" and less than 60" | Height: Any |
| Pieced Small Wall, Crib, Doll Quilt or Table Topper | 3900 – 4100 | Width less than 45" | Height: Any |
| Group – Three or More Quilters 4200 – 4400 | A quilt that involved three or more persons in the construction and quilting, of any size, using any technique. | | |
| Mixed Technique 5000 – 5200 | Any size quilt where a fairly even amount of multiple techniques are used to develop the design of the top. An example (but not limited to) would be a quilt of applique and piecing where neither technique dominates | | |

Categories for Quilts of Any Size

| | |
|---------------------------|---|
| Special Technique 5300 | The quilt is predominantly of a single special technique such as whole cloth, 3D work, photos, cross-stitch, embroidery, thread painting or fabric painting. Quilts in this category are more traditional in nature and do not otherwise fit in the Art Quilt category. |
| Modern Quilts 5400 | Quilt may feature high contrasting colors, minimalism, improvisational piecing, expansive negative space, and non-traditional layouts. |

| <p>Art/Innovative Quilts 6000</p> | <p align="center">Any Size</p> <p>An art quilt is an ORIGINAL WORK of visual art that may be inspired by other works but may not be a copy of another art quilt or a kit, pattern, or class project. In addition, an art quilt must have three layers, be made of fabric and be quilted. (See Other-Unquilted category for unquilted art work)</p> | |
| <p>Art –Pictorial 6100</p> | <p align="center">Any Size</p> <p>A quilt that represents a recognizable image of a person, place or thing. An art quilt must have three layers, be made of fabric and be quilted. Art quilts made from a kit, pattern or class project may be entered in this category (See Other-Unquilted category for unquilted art work)</p> | |
| <p>Miniature 7000</p> | <p>Width: less than or equal to 24" Height: less than or equal to 24"</p> | <p>A miniature quilt is small in scale throughout all aspects including block size, overall design, quilting stitch, borders and binding. (See wall quilt categories for small quilts that are not true miniatures)</p> |
| <p>Quilted Wearables 8000</p> | <p align="center">Any Size</p> <p>Any clothing items constructed of fabric and batted and quilted using any technique.</p> | |
| <p>Other – Quilted 9000</p> | <p align="center">Any Size</p> <p>Items that do not fit into any other category such as pillows, purses, tree skirts, tote bags and table runners. Items must contain three layers consisting of fabric, batting and back and the quilting must penetrate all three layers and be visible on front and back</p> | |
| <p>Other – Unquilted 9100</p> | <p align="center">Any Size</p> <p>Items in this category do <u>not</u> have to be quilted. They include Cathedral Windows, Yo-Yo quilts, purses, biscuit quilts, string pieced "Stitch-n-Flip", tied quilts and crazy quilts. All items must be made of cloth.</p> | |
